Hugh Daniel Smith is a multi-dimensional thinker and international speaker. He is known for his keen insight into spiritual matters and his unique ability to make them relevant to the times. He coaches individuals and families through the Redemptive Justice Practice, a private practice he founded to aid people with spiritual growth and personal development. He is the founder of the Diamond Leadership Academy.

Over the years Bishop Smith has served as an executive board member for many organizations and has received countless awards. In 2014, he was inducted into the Hall of Fame at Battle Creek Central High School. He has a Doctor of Theology Degree and a Doctor of Divinity Degree; and has been certified as a Life Skills Facilitator, assisting people in overcoming past and present emotional and psychological abuse.
